Taylor Made Science Tuition Payment Policies

Tuition can either be paid by sending a check through snail mail or paid through PayPal. The snail mail address is: 2509 W. Messick Loop, Round Rock, TX 78681. The PayPal tuition fees are a little higher to cover the fees charged by PayPal for using the service. These fees are nonrefundable. Please do not send tuition "person to person" to avoid the PayPal fees. Because my account is set up as a business account, I will still be charged the regular PayPal fees and your tuition payment will be incomplete.

Tuition payments for Taylor Made Science classes are due on the following dates:

First Semester	Second Semester
June 1 (or upon registration if after June 1)	January 1
September 1	February 1
October 1	March 1
November 1	April 1

A late fee of \$10 will be assessed after the 10th of the month in which tuition is due, no exceptions. If your check has not been received by the 10th of the month, please add an additional \$10 to the regular tuition amount. PayPal buttons will reflect the additional \$10 after the deadline.

Your child will receive a semester take home lab kit as part of their tuition cost this year. The cost of the supplies in this kit will be distributed evenly between the four tuition installments per semester. If you withdraw your child before the end of the semester, you will still owe the prorated cost of the supplies for the remainder of the semester. (Cost of lab kits is still unknown at this time, but it will be the actual cost to me to buy the materials for each kit.) Before the school year begins you will be able to pick up the kit or have it mailed to you. If you choose to have it mailed, you will be responsible for paying the shipping fee.

When you fill out the Taylor Made Science registration form you will be asked to check a box stating that you have read and agree to follow this Tuition Payment Agreement. Basically, you are agreeing to make tuition payments on time, to pay late fees if the deadlines are not met, and to pay the prorated cost of your child's lab kit if you withdraw before the end of the semester.
