Lab Kit Safety Information and Liability Waiver

Taylor Made Science supplies a basic materials lab kit to all science students so that they may complete the labs at home during online classes. Please be aware that this kit may contain toxic chemicals and other materials that may be harmful if not used according to written and verbal safety instructions. Parents are responsible for the maintenance and security of this lab kit at all times, including the following:

- 1. Keep all contents of the lab kit out of reach of young children and pets in the home. Contents may contain toxic chemicals, sharp objects, and/or small objects that can present a choking hazard.
- 2. Know where to locate all Safety Data Sheet (SDS) documentation if the need arises. SDS documents can be found at https://taylormadescience.com/onlinescience/lab-safety/ for all chemicals considered toxic and/or that are not already found commonly in your home.
- 3. Make sure that your science student uses the contents of the kit only as instructed in their science course. All materials will be needed during the year, and many will be used more than once. Ensure that your student takes care of all materials, keeps all materials together until the end of the school year, and keeps the kit securely stored between classes.
- 4. Make sure that your science student follows all instructions about disposal of waste produced during lab. Clean-up/disposal instructions will be given to students during the live, online class.
- 5. If any materials or supplies are lost or damaged and are still needed to complete labs throughout the year, the parent will be responsible for replacing the item(s) at their own expense. Please know that one kit is prepared for each child and no extra kits or materials are available from the teacher. The parent will have to find replacements or substitutes directly from stores and vendors.
- 6. The cost of the lab kit supplies is covered by the nonrefundable Lab Supply/Registration Fee that is paid at the time of registration. As part of their class, all supplies in the kit belong to the student and no materials need to be returned to the teacher. Please make sure that any leftover chemicals are disposed of properly at the end of the school year. Everything else may be kept and used by the student. Each year new kits are made that contain all equipment needed for that year. Students do not need to keep/reuse equipment from year to year.
